We use cookies to properly operate and develop the website, as well as to monitor the activity, collect statistics and improve user experience.

1. What are cookies?

Cookie is a small file or packet of data placed in your browser or on your device when you visit a website. Cookies allow the website to recognize the visitor on the next visit and thereby provide security, convenience features and improve user experience while browsing the website.

Cookies can be distinguished by their function, user, or storage period. There are cookies that are placed by the website operator (internal cookies) as well as those placed by third parties (external cookies).

The cookies used on websites of the **Social Futuring** and **Social Futuring** Index can be statistical, and convenience cookies based on their function.

Based on their storage period, we distinguish between session cookies, which are deleted as soon as the visitor closes the browser, and persistent cookies, which are stored by the visitor's browser until their save period expires or is deleted.

5. Categories of data subjects

REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons regarding the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) you can ask for accessing personal data, asking information data handled by the controllers.

The provision of information and copies of processed data is free of charge. Additional copies requested by you may be charged a reasonable fee based on the administrative cost,

(ii) request the rectification, erasure, or restriction of the processing of personal data concerning you,

(iii) request the controller to indicate which recipients have been informed of the rectification, erasure, or restriction of the processing,

(iv) if the legal basis for the data processing is your consent, you may withdraw your consent to the data processing at any time, however, the withdrawal of the consent does not affect the lawfulness of the data processing based on the consent prior to the withdrawal. The controller may also process personal data after the withdrawal of consent to fulfill their legal obligations or enforce its legitimate interests, if the enforcement of the interest is proportionate to the restriction of the right to the protection of personal data,

(v) if the legal basis for the processing is your consent, you may exercise your right to data portability: in relation to personal data concerning, you provided to you by the data controller and processed in an automated manner, you may request that data in a structured, widely used machine-readable format receive or transfer this data to another data controller.

You may also request that, where technically feasible, your personal data be transferred directly by the controller to the other controller,

(vi) if the legal basis for the processing is the legitimate interest of the controller [Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR] or the performance of a public task [Article 6 (1) (e) GDPR], you may object to the processing. An objection is a statement in which you object to the processing of your personal data.

6. Remedies

In connection with the lawfulness of data processing, the National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority (1125 Budapest, Szilágyi Erzsébet fasor 22 / C.,
